Step out with confidence... The North Devon Easy Access Trails are a selection of easy walks in and around the North Devon Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB), specially selected to ensure everyone can experience the delights of the North Devon landscape. Routes are colour coded to allow you to choose a walk to suit your ability. This walk is a **BROWN CODED ROUTE** with varying gradients, natural surfaces and gates on route. (Note: There is a significant slope at the Putsborough end of this route)

## Route Guide

All distances are approximate

**Green** - Flat level surface, gradient less than 1 in 12, benches on route, gates wheelchair accessible.

**Brown** - Varying gradients, minimum width 1m, natural surface, gates wheelchair accessible.

**Purple** - Natural surface, varying gradients, gates on route, no stiles but some steps.

**Pink** - No stiles but flights of steps with hand rails.

**Orange** - More difficult terrain in non of the above categories, could include some stiles.
